

WHAT TO BRING
(Camp Oakhurst's list of what "to" and "not to" bring)

Required Items:

Bible
Sleeping bag
Notebook
Pillow
Pen or Pencil
Towel

Clothing:

Jeans or sturdy pants
Casual shirts/blouses
Tennis or closed-toed shoes
Light jacket or sweater
Swimsuit (Girls: one-piece, and no high French cut – prefer you wear "board shorts" over swimsuit;) (Boys: no Speedos or cutoffs)
Socks
Underwear

Personal items:

Toothpaste

Soap
Any other items needed

Optional Items:

Swimming earplugs, Swimming goggles, Swimming nose plugs, Camera, Extra batteries, Film, Shorts, Bug spray, Letter writing materiel, Stamps, Shower flip-flops, Watch, Lip balm, Dental floss, Pajamas and slippers, Extra money for snacks, Facial tissue, Sanitary napkins, Alarm clock

IDENTIFY YOUR STUFF!
